After breakfast, we will visit Hassan II Mosque which is the most modernized in the world, and Mohammed V Square which is known as Pigeon Square. Then, join us as we travel to Marrakech! Today, we will be visiting the iconic building

of Marrakech - the Koutoubia Mosque, the costume designer Yve Saint Laurent (Yve Saint Laurent) and his partner Pierre Berge during his lifetime in Marrakech, Morocco. Fun fact, Yves Saint Laurent's private garden was purchased in Kashgar. Following, we will go to the largest park in Marrakech, Agdal Gardens. Stroll through the endless forest and feel the breath of every plant and tree! In the evening, you will come to the Square of Sleepless to feel a special infinite vitality of Marrakech!

#### **Hassan II Mosque**

This opulent mosque, built at enormous expense, is set on an outcrop jutting over the ocean with a 210m-tall minaret that's a city landmark. It's a showcase of the finest Moroccan artisanship: hand-carved stone and wood, intricate marble flooring and inlay, gilded cedar ceilings and exquisite zellige (geometric mosaic tilework) abound. It's one of two Moroccan mosques open to non-Muslims.

#### **Square of Mohammed V**

Mohammed V Square in Casablanca is popularly referred to as "Pigeons' Square." It seems literally carpeted with pigeons. The square is named for Mohammed V, celebrated former King of Morocco. New buildings went up around the square in the style of Moorish Revival so liked by architect Henri Proust.

#### **Koutoubia Mosque**

The mosque's minaret has been a standing guard over the old city since the Almohads erected it in the 12th century. Today it's Marrakesh's most famous landmark! The tower is known as a monumental cheat sheet of Moorish ornament: scalloped keystone arches, jagged merlon crenelations and mathematically pleasing proportions.

#### **Jardin Majorelle**

A French fashion designer named Yves Saint Laurent and his partner Pierre Bergé bought Jardin Majorelle in 1980 to preserve the vision of its original owner. The French landscape painter Jacques Majorelle was the original owner, and his mission was to always keep it open to the public.

#### **Agdal Gardens**

The Agdal Gardens are more than 850 years old. Created in 1157 during the Almohad dynasty, they extend over an area of 500 hectares – almost as big as the city itself at that time. The Agdal Gardens, listed as “World Cultural Heritage Site” by the UNESCO, are the biggest park in Marrakech and can look back on a turbulent history between neglect and reconstruction. The park is rather a huge grove of olive, pomegranate, and orange trees than a garden in the classic

sense. Although there is hardly a place to sit down and take a rest, you can relax here from the hustle and bustle of the Medina during an extended walk. Given clear weather, you can also see the silhouette of the Grand Atlas Mountains.

### **Djemaa El Fna**

You'll discover something unique everywhere you look in the Djemaa El Fna, Marrakesh's main square. The hoopla and halqa (street theater) have been here since the 11th century. Up until a few decades ago, the Djemaa El Fna hosted a daily food market for mountain traders.
