FALL: Great Slave Lake boating (incl. lunch)	C\$160+	Enjoy a scenic boat ride, get a close-up of the boat houses and savour an onshore lunch with cooked fish and fry.
FALL: Fishing at Great Slave Lake (no meal incl.)	C\$190+	Take a boat ride and enjoy unforgettable fishing experience at Great Slave Lake where is renowned for its abundant lake trout, arctic grayling, and northern pike. Cost of your sport fishing licence is included in the activity fee.
