**Zaanse Schans**

Zaanse Schans is a neighborhood in the Dutch town of Zaandam, near Amsterdam. Historic windmills and distinctive green wooden houses are relocated here to recreate the look of an 18th/19th-century like-villages. The Zaans Museum has regional costumes, model windmills and interactive exhibits on chocolate making. Artisan workshops even demonstrate rare handicrafts such as wooden clog carving, barrel making and pewter casting.

### **Manneken Pis**

Manneken Pis is a landmark small bronze sculpture located in central Brussels. The sculpture is part of a fountain that has a little boy urinating into the fountain's basin. It was designed by Jérôme Duquesnoy the Elder and put in place in 1618 or 1619; however, the current statue is a replica which dates from 1965.

### **Grand-Place Brussels**

Let's explore the Grand Place! The Grand Place is located at the central square of Brussels. The Grand Place is one of the greatest tourist destinations and the most memorable landmark in Brussels. It is also considered one of the most beautiful squares in Europe and has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1998.

### **Brussels Town Hall**

The Town Hall of the City of Brussels is a Gothic building from the Middle Ages. It is located on the famous Grand Place in Brussels, Belgium, across the Brussels City Museum. Interestingly enough, it is the only remaining medieval building of the Grand Place and is even considered to be a masterpiece of civil Gothic architecture.

The Arc de Triomphe is one of the most famous monuments in all of Paris, France. The Arc de Triomphe honors those who fought and died for France during the French Revolutionary and Napoleonic Wars. Beneath its vault lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier from World War I. It set the tone for public monuments with triumphant patriotic messages.

### **Avenue des Champs - Elysées**

The Avenue des Champs-Élysées is a Paris must-see! This unique avenue is said to be one of the greatest! The avenue is approximately 1.9 km long and 70 m wide, running between the Place de la Concorde and the Place Charles de Gaulle, where the Arc de Triomphe is located. It is known for its theatres, cafés, and numerous luxury shops. It also is home to famous annual Bastille Day military parade and as the finish of the Tour de France cycling race.

### **Place de la Concorde**

The Place de la Concorde is one of the major public squares in Paris, France. Measuring at about 19 acres in area, it is the largest square in the French capital. It was also notorious for the public executions of King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette in the course of the French Revolution.

### **Eiffel Tower**

You cannot visit Paris without seeing the Eiffel Tower! This global cultural icon of France is one of the most recognizable structures in the entire world! Today is your chance to see it in person and take as many pictures as you would like!

### **Seine River Cruise**

The Seine River divides the entire downtown area of Paris in two. The well-known Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, and Louvre are all built on the banks of the Seine River. This includes the biographies of the city's patron saints, St. Leodegar and St. Maurice. Lucerne's water tower is a powerful and attractive construction that you must see!

### Schwanenplatz

Schwanenplatz is situated on the right shore of Lake Lucerne/River Reuss next to the main highway bridge. It is a classic starting point for welcoming tourists into the old downtown area. The square itself is quite busy, but as soon as you enter into the small streets of downtown Lucerne, you will be amazed with what this place has to offer!

### Lion Monument

Lucerne's world-famous Lion Monument has been consistently impressing its visitors each and every year. The imposing stone lion, however, is more than "just" a monument. It can be seen as a commemoration, a work of art or a memorial. It is a powerful and proud landmark of the city of Lucerne.

### Titlis

Of all the highlights in Central Switzerland, TITLIS is the big one - and the only glacier in the entire region that is actually accessible. So come and enjoy the breathtaking panorama of snow-capped mountaintops and untouched Alpine landscapes. At 3,062 meters, the summit offers not only a breathtaking 360° panorama of the wide Engelberg valley but also a view straight down into the abyss, with countless crevasses carved into the glacial ice.

The structure consists of two glass-vaulted arcades intersecting in an octagon covering the street connecting Piazza del Duomo to Piazza della Scala. The street is covered by an arching glass and cast-iron roof, a popular design for 19th-century arcades and the central octagonal space is topped with a glass dome.

### **Milan Cathedral**
