### Day 1

### Belgrade - Vehicle - Zlatibor

All day

When you arrive at Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport (BEG), we will pick you up at the airport in advance. Start this Balkan exploration trip. First of all, welcome to Belgrade. This city is the capital of Serbia and is known as the key to the Balkans. Here you can admire a variety of buildings of different styles. Then we will go to the ruins of the Chinese Embassy in Yugoslavia, which was bombed by NATO aircraft in 1999 and three Chinese citizens died here. Then drive to Zlatibor, the sunny city of flowers. Next, we will go to Zlatibor's famous attraction: Wooden Village. The entire village is built by craftsmen purely using wood, which is incredible. After a day of fun, you will be sent back to your hotel in Zlatibor to check in and rest.

#### **Belgrade**

Belgrade is the capital of Serbia, located at the confluence of the Danube and Sava rivers. It is an important contact point between Europe and the Near East and is known as the key to the Balkans. In its long history, it has been a place where Eastern and Western cultures have been constantly blended and collided, which makes Belgrade full of fusion charm today. It has a variety of buildings with different styles, including oriental buildings in the Austro-Hungarian style, small town-style buildings in Central Europe, and modern buildings known as Brutalism.

#### **The ruins of the Chinese Embassy in Yugoslavia**

On May 7, 1999, it was bombed by NATO aircraft and three compatriots died. The Chinese Cultural Center is currently under construction. The only remaining commemorative plaque at the door reads in Serbian and Chinese: I would like to thank the People's Republic of China for its support and friendship during the most difficult moment for the people of the Republic of Serbia, and hereby commemorate the fallen martyrs.

### **Zlatibor**

The city of bright flowers is not as famous as Provence, but it makes people fall in love with it at first sight, and will remind you of the paradise in the East and the fairy tale world in the West. Time flows slowly here, and people's pace slows down unconsciously.

### **Drvengrad**

It is a very famous attraction in Zlatibor. It is a utopian city built by Serbian director Emile Kusturic for the film "Life is a Miracle". The whole village is built by hand using wood. In the film, it is a complete society with public facilities such as churches, libraries, cinemas, restaurants, etc. It opposes globalization and is an isolated paradise.

## **Day 2**

**Zlatibor** - Vehicle - **Zabljak** - Vehicle - **Podgorica**

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### **All day**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will bid farewell to the ancient town of Zlatibor and drive to Durmitor National Park in Žabljak. The park's terrain was formed by glaciers and is crisscrossed by rivers and undercurrents. In 1980, Durmitor National Park was included in the World Heritage Natural Heritage List by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization. Then we will go to the Tara Bridge, which spans the Tara Valley, the deepest gorge in Europe, with a total length of 366 meters. After the tour, we will drive to the hotel in Podgorica to check in and rest.

### **Durmitor National Park**

A beautiful natural park, it was formed by glaciers, including above-ground and underground rivers. It includes the alpine lake "Black Lake" and the famous Tara River Canyon Bridge. It was listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1980. The reinforced concrete highway bridge was first built in 1940 and was bombed during World War II. It was restored and preserved after the victory of the anti-fascist war in 1946. The former Yugoslav movie "The Bridge" that was once popular in China was adapted and filmed here based on the historical facts of the guerrillas bombing the bridge.

### **Durdevica Tara Bridge**

This 365-metre-long bridge has five arches, and the largest span is 116 meters. The roadway stands 172 meters above the Tara River. It is also the location of the anti-fascist film "Bridge."

## **Day 3**

### **Podgorica - Vehicle - Tirana**

All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will first visit the beautiful, quiet and livable city at our feet - Podgorica, the capital of Montenegro. Here you will be taken to visit the Serbian Orthodox Cathedral - Cathedral of Christ the Savior. Then we will drive to the largest lake in the Balkan Peninsula: Lake Shkodra, which is also located near the border between Russia and Afghanistan. After admiring the charming scenery around the lake, we will bid farewell to Montenegro and arrive in Tirana, the capital of Albania. In this historic capital, we will visit a series of old-fashioned buildings with traditional characteristics. Feel the imprint left by history across time. After the tour, you will check into the hotel in Tirana and rest.

### **podgorica**

It is the capital of Montenegro and the capital of the Podgorica Region. The river is clear, calm and flows quietly through the city. It has a typical Mediterranean climate, with hot and dry summers and wet and rainy winters. The city is surrounded by mountains. In spring and summer, you can see the snow on the northeastern mountains. People often describe this city as "beautiful, quiet and livable". Indeed, Podgorica is a village in the city and a city in the village.

### **Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ Podgorica**

Podlica Cathedral is a Serbian Orthodox church located in Podlica, the capital of Montenegro. It is a typical Eastern Orthodox church with magnificent interior decoration and exquisite murals on the walls and roof. They are all Christian stories, and religious music is played in the church. The construction of the church began in 1993 and was completed on October 7, 2014. The church was dedicated to the 1700th anniversary of the issuance of the Edict of Milan, which declared religious freedom.

### **Skadar Lake**

The largest lake in the Balkan Peninsula. Located on the border between Montenegro and Albania. Originally a seaside lagoon, it deepened due to a slight subsidence of the earth's crust. 12 km from the Adriatic Sea, the lake surface is 12 meters above sea level. 40 km long, 6.4-12 km wide, with an area of 370 square kilometers (222 square kilometers of which belong to Yugoslavia). Maximum depth 44 meters. It is fed by river water and a small amount of groundwater. In winter, the water volume increases and the lake surface can expand by one third.

### **Tirana**

It is the capital and largest city of Albania. Tirana is a city with a long history. The eastern and northern parts of the city are mainly the old town, where most of the old buildings have traditional characteristics. There are theaters, museums and concert halls in the city. The old song "Songs Flying to Tirana" which was once popular will evoke people's memories of the period of friendship between China and Albania.

### **Orthodox Autocephalous Church of Albania**

The largest Orthodox church in Tirana was newly built in 2008. The Albanian Orthodox Church is independent of other Orthodox Churches, so the church is also different from the onion-shaped churches in Russia.

### **E'them Bey Mosque**

This mosque is located on the right side of Skanderbeg Square in the center of Tirana. It was built in the 19th century and is considered a cultural relic in Tirana. Albania is a country with a mixture of religions, but many Albanians still believe in Islam, so this mosque still has a very important status in Tirana.

## Skanderbeg Square

It is a famous square in Tirana. Its name comes from the Albanian national hero Skanderbeg in 1468. A monument to Skanderbeg stands on the square. Standing in the center of the square and looking east, the trendy TID commercial building designed by Belgium, the government building, the mosque and the clock tower are all together, showing the mixed history of Albania in a difficult way.

## Day 4

**Tirana** - Vehicle - **Budva** - Vehicle - **Kotor**

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All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will leave Tirana and see Agios Stefano Island across the sea. This is an island surrounded by blue sea, with only a stone road leading inland. Then we will go to Budva, located on the Adriatic Sea, and deeply experience the Venetian luxury and sophistication revealed in every detail of the city. Then proceed to another medieval town - Kotor. Because the original appearance of the ancient city is relatively intact, you must first cross the moat before entering the city. After experiencing the different charms and customs of the two gulf cities, we will specially arrange for you to take a boat trip to Perast to visit the island in the middle of the lake (the details will depend on the weather conditions of the day. If canceled due to force majeure, our company will provide a full refund This tour activity fee will be reimbursed). After the tour, you will check into the hotel in Kotor for dinner and rest.

## **Sveti Stefan**

Originally a fishing village with a history dating back to the 15th century, it gradually developed into a resort due to its beautiful scenery and clear sea water. Today, it is one of the most beautiful and precious islands in the world, and a favorite resort for many European and American aristocrats, celebrities, and stars.

## **Budva**

Located on the Adriatic Sea, it is a famous tourist destination in the Balkan Peninsula. It is famous for its beautiful beaches, rich nightlife and unique Mediterranean architecture. Budva has been controlled by Venice for a long time, and every detail in the city reveals Venetian luxury. The blue water, the exquisite gardens in the city, and the numerous luxury restaurants and bars on the beach attract a large number of celebrities and wealthy people from all over the world to come here for vacation every year.

## **Kotor**

It is a medieval town located on the east coast of Kotor Bay on the Adriatic Sea. It is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site because its ancient appearance is well preserved. To get to the ancient town, you must first pass through the moat. The ancient city walls surrounding the ancient city of Kotor, which were built continuously from the 9th to the 18th century, form a beautiful picture with the impregnable walls and the clear green moat.

## **Perast Old Town**

Set in the Bay of Kotor, this Baroque town reached its heyday in the 17th and 18th centuries with shipping and commerce, with 100 merchant ships and crews renowned for their skill and courage. The beautiful palaces of these famous seafaring families still remain today.

## **Day 5**

**Kotor - Vehicle - Mostar - Vehicle - Sarajevo**

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### All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will say goodbye to Montenegro and drive to Mostar. The old city center with the Old Bridge in Mostar is the most famous tourist spot in Mostar, and in 2005 it was approved by the UNESCO World Heritage Committee to be included in the World Heritage List as a cultural heritage. Today's itinerary will take you to see the world cultural heritage, and we will also arrange a special thumb meat strip meal for you at noon. At the same time, the ancient city of Mostar fully demonstrates the primitive style and artistic style of Bosnia in the 16th century, waiting for your exploration. After the tour, you will drive to your hotel in Sarajevo to check in and rest.

**Mostar**

Mostar is also known as the City of the Neretva River because it spans the deep valley of the Neretva River. For centuries, Mostar has attracted countless tourists with its charming natural scenery and unique cultural landscape, and is known as the "Garden of Paradise". There are medieval Roman architectural monuments in the city. Pochitel in the south of the city is famous for its Islamic architecture.

**The Old City of Mostar**

Small shops selling carpets, jewelry, traditional clothing, ties and pipes can be found everywhere, as well as many souvenir shops and handicraft shops with a wide variety of products. The Old Town of Mostar, which straddles the deep valley of the Retva River, was established as a Turkish border town in the 15th and 16th centuries and further developed during the Austro-Hungarian Empire in the 19th and 20th centuries.

**The Old Bridge In Mostar**

Located in the center of Mostar, it was once described as "a rainbow welcoming the Milky Way" and is one of the famous attractions in the entire Balkan Peninsula. The style of the ancient stone bridge is in harmony with the surrounding buildings made of ancient stones and the ancient streets paved with round cobblestones, fully demonstrating the quaint customs and artistic style of Bosnia in the 16th century. In 2005, the bridge and the surrounding area were listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

**Day 6**

**Sarajevo - Vehicle - Turaz**

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All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will visit Sarajevo, known as the "Jerusalem of Europe" because of its religious diversity, and start today's itinerary. We will go to the main street of Sarajevo's old town, which still retains its appearance 500 years ago, and look for the old clock tower in the street. We will also go to Coppersmith Street to experience the vitality of ancient traditional crafts in the modern world. Following the pace of exploration, we will come to the Ottoman-style mosque in the city center, and then to the historic Latin Bridge, as if we can see what happened here several years ago. After the tour, you will drive to the hotel in Turaz for dinner, check-in and rest.

#### **Bascarsija**

It is the main street of Sarajevo's old town. It was built in the 16th century and still retains its appearance 500 years ago. It has the country's unique and colorful market center. Many buildings in the old town are the filming locations of the movie "Walter Defends Sarajevo".

#### **Sarajevska Sahat-Kula**

The clock tower was built in 1667. The clock tower in Sarajevo is 30 meters high. The clock on it is made in Italy. It is the only public clock in the city and the only public clock in the world that measures the moon, that is, Turkish time, and determines the prayer time accordingly.

#### **Kazandziliuk**

Coppersmith Street is one of the oldest and most charming streets in Sarajevo. It has existed since the 15th century and was once the core area of Sarajevo's handicraft business district. In its heyday, there were hundreds of copper daily necessities made here. Balkan women have the habit of using copper ornaments. The copper craft was introduced from the Ottoman Empire and is still a protected and even iconic handicraft in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

#### **Gazi Husrev Beg's Mosque**

Located in the heart of the old town of Sarajevo, it is a typical Ottoman-style building and one of the famous mosques in Sarajevo. It later became the world's first mosque with electricity. Built in 1531, it was damaged during the civil war and rebuilt in the 1990s. It is now the largest and most important historical building and Islamic religious center in the

entire Yugoslavia.

### **Latin Bridge**

A bridge located in the city center, rebuilt in 1798, has profound historical significance. At the north end of the bridge is the scene of the Sarajevo incident, which was the fuse of World War I.

### **Tunnel of Hope**

An important life passage during the siege of Sarajevo has been preserved. The documentary shows images of the war. You can walk through the most dangerous tunnel during the Sarajevo War, about 25 meters long, and feel the cruelty of the war era.

## **Day 7**

### **Turaz - Vehicle - Belgrade**

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All day

After breakfast at the hotel, we will drive back to Belgrade, the capital of Serbia. Throughout its long history, this city has carried the constant blending and collision of Eastern and Western cultures, which makes Belgrade today full of fusion charm. First we will go to the St. Sava Cathedral, which dominates the entire city. Sometimes we can also see local couples holding weddings here. Then we will visit the Kalemegdan Castle, where you can see the architectural heritage of ancient Rome and the Austro-Hungarian Empire. The last stop was to the cemetery of Tito, the famous leader of Yugoslavia. This cemetery is also a flower house full of flowers. In the evening, a Serbian-style barbecue meal is prepared for you to bring a perfect end to this Balkan trip.

### **Church of Saint Sava**

Built in 1935, it is the largest Orthodox church in the world and one of the top ten cathedrals in the world. Dedicated to the founder Saint Sava, it has gone through many twists and turns in its construction and is one of the most magnificent buildings in Belgrade, symbolizing the cohesion and indomitable spirit of the Serbian nation.

### **Belgrade Fortress**

An important fortress in Belgrade during the Middle Ages, it is now a landmark tourist attraction and leisure place in Belgrade. The entire castle is built of huge stones and was once an important military base. Historical cannons can still be found in the park. The castle has been repaired and expanded many times in history, and the architectural style of ancient Rome and the Austro-Hungarian Empire can still be seen today.

### **House of Flowers**

Also known as the Flower House, it is the cemetery of Tito, a famous leader of the Yugoslav Federation. Since Tito loved to grow flowers during his lifetime, his body was buried in the flower house after his death. Under Tito's leadership, Yugoslavia was in a golden age. To this day, people go to Tito's tomb to offer their own flowers to express their remembrance of Tito.
