(Check in at the hotel after 2:00 pm with passport ID)</p> <p>Auckland is the economic, cultural, shipping and tourism center of New Zealand and the largest port city in New Zealand. Queen Street is the most concentrated commercial area in Auckland. Both sides of the street are lined with 19th-century European-style buildings. There are various shopping malls, department stores, antique shops and various boutique shops. New Zealand's most famous university, the University of Auckland, is also located in the middle section of Queen Street. participation :

1. Please inquire at the hotel front desk for breakfast charges for children under 4 years old and not occupying a bed.
2. The entire tour will be conducted in Chinese, and no English translation will be provided. Fees for non-Asians will be negotiated separately ;
3. Guests are required to stay with the group for the entire journey. If they withdraw on the day of

departure or in the middle of the tour, they will be deemed to have given up automatically for any reason, and all fees will not be refunded .

4. The tour price does not include additional costs arising from unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances. Including personal needs, flight delays/cancellations, war/potential threats of war, riots, civil unrest, terrorist activities/threats of actual terrorist activities, natural disasters, severe environmental weather, etc.;

Cancellation policy :

- A deposit of US \$ 3 00 is required when registering, and the remaining balance must be paid 14 days before departure.
- If canceled or changed 14-30 working days before departure, the deposit of US \$ 3 00/person will not be refunded;
- If canceled or changed within 7-14 working days before departure, the full tour fee will not be refunded.
- If hotel prices increase during holidays, surcharges will be notified separately.
- If you are unable to travel due to personal reasons (such as being diagnosed with COVID-19 or becoming a close family contact), it is recommended to purchase personal travel insurance.

Booking instructions , recommended flights:

- Outbound: Any flight arriving in Auckland on the afternoon of the first day , hotel check-in time is after 2 pm ; Return: Any flight departing Auckland at any time on the last day, hotel check-out time is 10 am.
- Guests who miss the airport pick-up for any reason will have to solve their own transportation problems to the next stop, and all costs incurred and derived therefrom will be borne by themselves.
- All projects in the itinerary will be determined based on actual conditions (such as epidemic, weather, traffic, etc. force majeure). The company reserves the right to make adjustments to the itinerary based on actual conditions, and guests are not allowed to request compensation for this.
