We please ask that you patiently wait for other passengers to arrive at the airport before transferring to the hotel. The wait time may vary and depends on the bus schedule.
2. Vancouver International Airport (YVR) paid pick-up and drop-off services: For flights arriving between 07:00-23:00, the first two passengers will be charged \$100 (USD\$80), and each additional guest after that will be charged \$25 (USD\$20). Please be aware that there is a maximum of four people per order.
3. For all guests who collect luggage and meet with the guide before 12:15, you may pay \$1 to participate in the 3-hour Vancouver tour. Please patiently wait in the airport lobby and we will depart from the airport at 12:30.

Shannon Falls

Visit the amazing Shannon Falls with us today! Shannon Falls is composed of a series of cliffs, rising 335 meters above Highways 99 and is the third highest waterfall in the province. Shannon Falls even offers the best views and hikes for people to enjoy and explore.

Seton Lake

Seton Lake is a lake in the Squamish-Lillooet region of southwestern British Columbia. It is a freshwater fjord. The blue lake is calm, with the reflection of green mountains and beautiful scenery. On the northeast side is Mission Ridge. On the southwest is the Cayoosh Range. By road, the eastern end is about 7 kilometres (4.3 mi) southwest of Lillooet.

The Mile "0" Cairn

The Mile '0' Cairn was erected in 1939, marking Mile '0' of the old Cariboo Road. From this point in the early stage coach days, all road houses and stopping places from here to Barkerville were known by their mileage from Lillooet - 70 Mile, 100 Mile, and so on.

The Mile 0 Cairn is where the U.S. Army surveyors designated the beginning of the Alaska Highway. This renowned landmark is one of the most photographed subjects.

Day 3

**108 Mile House - Vehicle - Farwell Canyon - Vehicle - Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park -

All day

Today we will first go to Farwell Canyon, where the sand dunes and strange peaks and rocks are fascinating. This place has been of great significance to the Aboriginal people for generations and is an important salmon fishing area. Then go to Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park to observe bears, eagles and other wild animals. You can stroll here and immerse yourself in the magnificent scenery of the wilderness when inspiration strikes.

Itinerary:

108 Mile House → Farwell Canyon (60 mins) → Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park → Belarko Wildlife Viewing Platform (60 mins, lunch time included) → Bella Coola

Note: The opening time of the Belarko Wildlife Viewing Platform is from 09/01/2025 to 09/30/2025. During its closure, the itinerary will be changed to observe wildlife activities in other areas of Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park.

Farwell Canyon

Farwell Canyon in Riske Creek, British Columbia, Canada is an easy-access exceptional sightseeing destination in the Central Cariboo-Chilcotin Region. The canyon is a good stop on any trip when seeking hoodoo canyon views, wildlife viewing opportunities and a taste of the region's history. Farwell Canyon is best known for the Chilcotin River, hoodoos and sightseeing Big Horn Sheep. The scenery is best viewed from the lookout ridge fronting the canyon. From the ridge, looking down into the canyon, one can see the aqua-grey coloured Chilcotin River carving a path along the canyon floor.

Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park

Tweedsmuir South Provincial Park is a wilderness area located in British Columbia, Canada. It was established on May 21, 1938 in the western interior of the province to protect its important natural landscape. It covers over 989,616 acres and offers a wide range of recreational opportunities, including hiking, fishing, camping, and wildlife viewing. The park is home to several glaciers, lakes, and rivers, making it a popular destination for outdoor enthusiasts.

Belarko Wildlife Viewing Platform

Belarko Wildlife Viewing Platform is located on Highway 20, 13 kilometers within the western boundary of Tweedsmuir Provincial Park, adjacent to the Belarko Boat Landing. The goal of the Belarko Wildlife Viewing Platform is to reduce risks to humans and bears and other wildlife. The platform is surrounded by an electric fence supported by cedar railings to enhance public safety.

The platform provides visitors with the opportunity to observe bears and other wildlife in their natural habitat. The platform offers stunning views of the Atnaco River. The best time to see them is during the salmon spawning season in late summer and early fall.

Day 4

Bella Coola Free Time

All day

Today we will visit Bella Coola. Because it is close to the world-famous Great Bear Rainforest, the small town of Bella Coola has also become a paradise for photography enthusiasts. Whether it is hiking, watching wildlife, or participating

in an exciting rafting experience, here people can feel the natural fun away from the urban jungle! You can walk freely around the town or choose to participate in our carefully prepared experiential activities.

Recommended Optional Activity 1: the glacier fjord and hot springs Day Tour (Day tour resources are tight, it is strongly recommended that you prepay in advance to ensure resources. The resource inventory is limited, first come first served!!!)

Duration: 6-7 hours

Price: \$320.00/person (lunch included: including sandwiches, snacks and cold drinks)

The Port of Bella Coola at the end of Highway 20 is the starting point of your sea trip. The experienced captain will take you to visit local historical sites and tell you anecdotes about the area. From the cape to South Bentinck Bay, you will have the opportunity to see seals, dolphins, humpback whales and killer whales along the way, as well as bears, wolves and eagles. Wildlife such as. After arriving at the hot springs, you can soak in the clear natural mineral hot springs and enjoy the soothing moments of the journey. We will then take a boat to the waterfalls formed by large glacial water sources in the mountains to cool off, see the big cedar trees in Raso Bay and the mysterious ancient Aboriginal hieroglyphs, and return to Bella Coola Harbor in the afternoon.

Recommended Optional Activity 2: Petroglyph tour (Day tour resources are tight, it is strongly recommended that you prepay in advance to ensure resources. The resource inventory is limited, first come first served!!!)

Nuxalkulmc is also the home of ancient petroglyphs – rock carvings. A very sacred & spiritual place. Ancient songs and stories will echo in the forest and your soul, providing a truly rare experience where you will learn about the rich history and culture of the Nuksak people.

Duration: 2.5 hours

Recommended Optional Activity 3: Paddle With Giants - Paddle (Day tour resources are tight, it is strongly recommended that you prepay in advance to ensure resources. The resource inventory is limited, first come first served!!!)

As your paddle strokes propel you through the waters of the inner fjord, surrounded by the Pacific Coast Mountains, you will truly feel like you're paddling with giants.

Bella Coola is an unincorporated community located in the Bella Coola Valley in British Columbia, Canada. Bella Coola often refers to the entire valley, which includes Bella Coola proper ("the township"), Lower Bella Coola, Hagensburg, Salumpt, Noosasum, Firval and Stui. Bella Coola (the name of both the town and the valley) is a favorite destination for naturalists, artists, explorers and photographers, with its clean air, glacial rivers, clear mountain streams and

magnificent wildlife. There are a variety of activities to suit all interests. From hiking and fishing to wildlife watching and cultural experiences, there is something for everyone to enjoy in this beautiful corner of British Columbia.

Day 5

Bella Coola - Vehicle - Tweedsmuir Provincial Park - Vehicle - William Lake

All day

This morning we will depart from Bella Coola Lake and head to Tweedsmuir Provincial Park. There are several glaciers, lakes and rivers in the park, where we will have an exciting bear watching, fishing and rafting experience. Drift quietly along the winding trails of the Atnaco River and watch bears forage and care for their cubs in their natural environment. We can not only follow the tracks of black and brown bears, but also see the very rare figure of the spirit bear. From the end of August, thousands of salmon come to local rivers to spawn - the final stage of their life cycle. For bears, salmon is an easy meal. Many bears and other wildlife gather on the river to feast before the long winter. Glide past foraging bears, stop on the banks of less traveled rivers to observe their behavior up close, and take a fascinating ecological walk with bears. Overnight in William Lake.

Itinerary:

Bella Coola → Tweedsmuir Provincial Park (3 hours) → William Lake

Note: The departure dates in September has a high chance of capturing the spectacle of bears catching salmon; Wildlife activities are due to uncontrollable human factors, and the observed animal activities on that day may vary. We apologize for any inconvenience caused.

Tweedsmuir Provincial Park

Tweedsmuir Provincial Park covers 981,000 hectares (2,428,000 acres) and is the largest park in British Columbia. This narrow, triangular park encompasses rugged mountains, sparkling rivers, BC's largest old-growth forest, and pristine wilderness in the heart of British Columbia, providing wildlife with the range they need to survive.
